

Chiang Mai Rajabhat University Announcement

on

Conducting On-Site Teaching and Learning in the 1st Semester of Academic Year 2022

To conduct teaching and learning of Chiang Mai Rajabhat University effectively under the measures for prevention and control of the spread of Coronavirus Disease (COVID-19) according to the order of the government, together with the Regulation Issued under Section 9 of the Emergency Decree on Public Administration in Emergency Situations B.E.2548, Urgent Letter from the Office of the Ministry of Higher Education, Science, Research and Innovation No. 82. 02000.6/2 15982, dated on 28th October 2021, and the Order of Chiang Mai Communicable Disease Committee No.25/2565 dated on 1st February 2022 on the Measures for Using Buildings or Places Conducting Teaching and Learning.

Therefore, in order to conduct teaching and learning in the 1st semester of academic year 2022 of Chiang Mai Rajabhat University effectively and to reduce the risk of the spread of Coronavirus Disease (COVID-19), the academic executive committee, Chiang Mai Rajabhat University meeting no.6/2022, dated on 10th May 2022, and the university administrative committee meeting no. 5/2022, dated on 25th May 2022 hereby agree to announce conducting on-site teaching and learning to practice as follows:

- 1. To conduct teaching and learning in the form of on-site in every course from 20th June 2022 onwards.
- 2. To conduct teaching and learning in the classrooms are required to follow the Chiang Mai Rajabhat University Announcement on Measures for Prevention and Control the Spread of Coronavirus Disease (COVID-19) in the 1st Semester of Academic Year 2022.
 - 3. To administer mid-term and final examination in the form of on-site in every course.
- 4. In case of comprehensive examination/qualifying examination or concept paper/thesis/independent study defense examination in graduate programs, online platform or integrated online meeting system can be practiced.

5. The President shall be in charge of the compliance with this announcement with the authority of interpreting and ordering. In cases where there is an issue, the President shall have the authority to order and determine the measures and guidelines for implementing as appropriate and in accordance with the situation that change according to the announcement of the Center for COVID-19 Situation Administration, and Ministry of Higher Education, Science, Research and Innovation, and the final decision shall be made by the President.
